2024-25 Costs for Pack 3000

- **Scouting America Membership fees of \$85** must be paid directly to Atlanta Area Council to join the Scouts (a \$15 Scout Life Subscription is optional)

- **Pack dues of \$170** are due to help cover: Neckerchiefs, patches, advancement awards, handbooks, and many of our events
- A **sibling discount** of \$20 per Scout will be given after the 1st Scout (**\$150 in Pack dues**)
- Pack dues will be invoiced following the first Pack Meeting and are due by **September 15th**
- Other events and trips are an additional “pay-as-you-go” fee, which will be communicated in advance prior to the event / trip.

Class A: Blue shirt with the following patches:

- Left sleeve
 - Atlanta Area Council BSA – If you are getting a shirt from the store, this is already attached
 - Pack number – 3000 (you'll need to get four separate digits)
- Right sleeve
 - Flag- If you are getting a shirt from the store, this is already attached
 - Den number – Lions 3, Tigers 4, Wolves 1, Bears 6, Webelos 2, AOL 8
- Above the left front pocket
 - World Crest If you are getting a shirt from the store, this is already attached
